As we gathered in circle, Wanja talked about her life on the farm, her passion as a weaver and what life was like for her at home. She also graciously shared many stories about her Reiki experiences including how surprised she was to discover that the bread she made suddenly took less time to rise after she received Reiki!

My favorite story was her deep concern about the elephants in a zoo. She told of how they communicated their unhappiness to her and what they wanted as a living environment. Using Reiki, she explained how she worked to create a better habitat for them and that this had recently become a reality.
